

Stop the spread of germs and help prevent the spread of the COVID-19.



Sights and attractions. Anyone over the age of 3 must wear a mask when indoors.

- To prevent heat stroke while outdoors, you may remove your mask if you are maintaining proper social distance guidelines (2 meters or more).
- Removal of masks are allowed when eating or drinking. Abide by the "no coughing" etiquette when masks are not worn.
- Staff members will be wearing masks or face shields while assisting customers however they may take their masks off when outdoors, maintaining proper social distancing



Hand sanitizer will be available at each facility.

- If no soap and water is available, use hand sanitizer.
- When entering a facility, use the hand sanitizer provided.
- Clean and disinfect touched objects and surfaces such as seats, handrails, tables, etc frequently.



Temperatures will be taken before entering a facility.

- If your temperature is over 37.5 degrees celsius, you will not be permitted to enter.
- Stay at home and avoid others if you are experiencing symptoms such as coughing, fever, or shortness of breath.
- Refrain from visiting the venue if you are experiencing flu-like symptoms, have been in close contact with someone who has symptoms or has tested positive for COVID-19, or have travelled overseas within the last 14 days.



Admittance will be limited due to COVID-19 precautions.

- Businesses may be temporarily closed due to improper ventilation inside of the facility.
- Tables and seating areas will be decreased so proper social distancing can be obtained.



To avoid large gatherings, queues will fall under proper social distancing guidelines and thus wait times may be longer than usual.

- If indoor capacity is reached due to social distancing guidelines, reception points for further explanations could be held outdoors.
- Meetings held in person are subject to be cancelled or modified to maintain proper social distancing.
